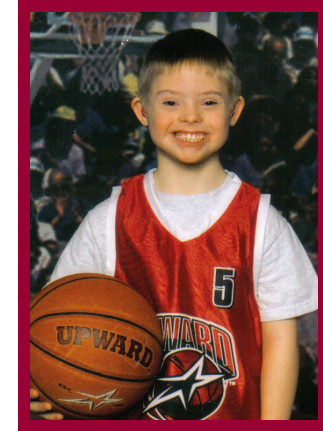

In 1975, a group of parents came together because they wanted to understand what going to school would mean for their children with special needs. Prior to that, most of these children were not permitted to attend public school because of their disabilities. Today, IN\*SOURCE employs 32 parents of children with disabilities. 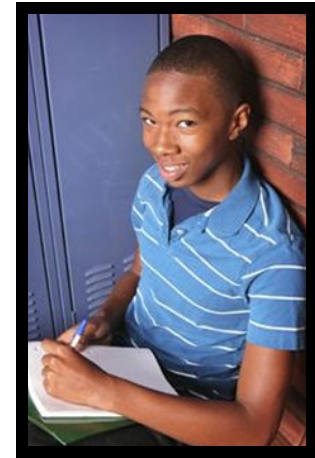
